

## God's Plan of Salvation:

- In the beginning, God made people in His image to have a relationship with Him (See Genesis 1- 2).
- But people disobeyed God, which is called sin, and the consequence of that sin is eternal punishment in a place called hell (See Genesis 3).
- All of us have sinned against God and deserve eternal punishment (See Romans 3:23 and 6:23).
- But God is rich in mercy and grace and desires to forgive and restore a people to Himself (See Ephesians 2:4).
- Therefore, God sent His son, Jesus Christ, to pay for our sin by dying on the cross (See Romans 5:8).
- If you sense a need to be saved from your sin, put your trust in the Lord Jesus Christ and you will be saved (See Acts 16:31)
- When God saves people, they are forgiven of their sin and adopted into His family as children (See Ephesians 1:5, Romans 8:1, and 1John 3:1-2).
- God desires His children to grow and mature in their trust of Him (See 2Peter 3:18).
- God wants His children to become more like His Son, Jesus Christ through discipleship (See Philippians 2:5- 11).
